


The 2015 ScubaSwap — Saturday, April 25, 2015.



Risk Assessment for Asian Carps in Canada

There are five species collectively known as the Asian carps: grass carp, bighead carp, silver carp, largescale silver carp and black carp. Four of these species (grass, bighead, silver, and black carps) have been introduced worldwide for aquaculture purposes.

Subsequent to introduction into the southern United States, three species have become established in the wild (grass, bighead and silver carps). Two of these species, bighead and silver carps, have been dispersing rapidly up the Mississippi River basin, wreaking ecological havoc along the way.

As there are numerous connections between the Mississippi basin and Canadian watersheds, including the Great Lakes, there is considerable concern about their potential ecological impacts if introduced and established in Canada. In addition to natural dispersal, these species may also be introduced into the Canadian wild through the live food fish trade.

Canada represents over 50% of the market for grass and bighead carps cultured in the United States.

On February 3 2015, a group of EUC members attended an Asian Carp Information Session.

Each of the several speakers from the University of Toronto, Department of Fisheries and Oceans, Ministry of Natural Resources, shared what their departments were doing to head off an Asian Carp Invasian. We learned that the invaders are not here yet and so Canada's best stategy was prevention.

We also learned of the various inspection programs and the numerous studies being undertaken to assess whether and how the carp might enter and spread. Among those studies was a program to DNA sample various water sources for evidence of the non native fish. The carp DNA can be detected in very low quantities and the Fisheries staff are collecting water samples from shoreline locations for analysis.

What can we as DIVERS do to help?

After the presentation, I talked to Dr. Nick Mandrak (U of T researcher with whom I previously collaborated on the ROM Field Guide to Freshwater Fishes) and to Becky Cudmore, Fisheries and Oceans (a former ROMulan herself) and suggested that we divers have the unique perspective of viewing wildlife and habitats from underwater.

It is my intention to followup with Nick and Becky on the feasibility of implementing our own Asian Carp Prevention Program. It may be that we would be able to take water samples for lab analysis from offshore locations and at depths beyond their reach.

I already have a committee started. Anyone interested in participating can let me know.
