EUC DIVE TRIPS ABROAD



Finding Prehistoric Nemo I built a prehistoric tropical reef for the Smithsonian!

On June 8 2019, the Smithsonian Natural History Museum in Washington DC opened the doors to its newest exhibit hall **DEEP TIME**. This exhibition showcases the museum's collection of 46 million fossils, presents the most up-to-date scientific research on how life on Earth has evolved, and displays the fossil record in new ways to show how dinosaurs and other extinct creatures lived in changing environments.

For the past year I have been "off the grid" working full time on my little piece of the exhibit. I had my hand in several other components of the hall too but this was my baby. It all started in a barn near Algonquin Park. My home workshop was much too small to work on this project and I needed a larger space. I spent most of the year commuting from my home in Caledon to beautiful Bancroft. I call it "the year of the Kawartha Dairy milkshake"...the best in the world.

This tropical reef from the Permian period around 252 million years ago, tells the story of the greatest extinction event the earth has known to date that killed off more than 96 percent of the planet's marine species. And by the way, it was caused by volcanic emmissions of the same kind of gases humans are pouring into the atmosphere today... part of the exhibit's message. The fossil record from this time period shows that before modern corals evolved, the reef builders of the day included giant shelf-like sponges and various types of extinct clam-like shells called brachiopods.

My diorama reconstructs this reef community for the first time in a full scale model. The giant sponges (the big yellow shelves) were first carved from insulation styrofoam mostly with a chain saw. The texture was then modelled in concrete to satisfy museum fire regulations, then painted. The 21 interlocking sponge ledges, reef wall and sea floor pieces were assembled on a welded steel frame custom built to support it. Because the door into the glass case at the museum was only 4 ft wide, the diorama needed to be transported in pieces and assembled on site.

For the background mural, I engaged an award winning digital artist from Vancouver. We worked closely together on the design and details of the background mural to ensure its integration with the 3D foreground. The mural was printed on vinyl and installed like wallpaper by the exhibit production staff prior to the foreground installation.

Once on site at the museum, the assembled reef foreground took me another 2 1/2 weeks to detail, patch seams and install the critters. The models were individually installed by drilling holes in the concrete and hot glueing them in, including hundreds maybe thousands of brachiopod shells...one at a time...just sayin'. While I did make some of the other animals myself back at home, most of the models were salvaged from the old exhibit which featured them in a different scene. In addition to museum curatorial input, I applied my knowlege and diving experiences to place the animals, making little vignettes from my own observations. See the little ray under the reef ledge?

This installation was one of my larger and most challenging projects to date. But hey...my work is now on permanent exhibit at the Smithsonian for all the world to see.
